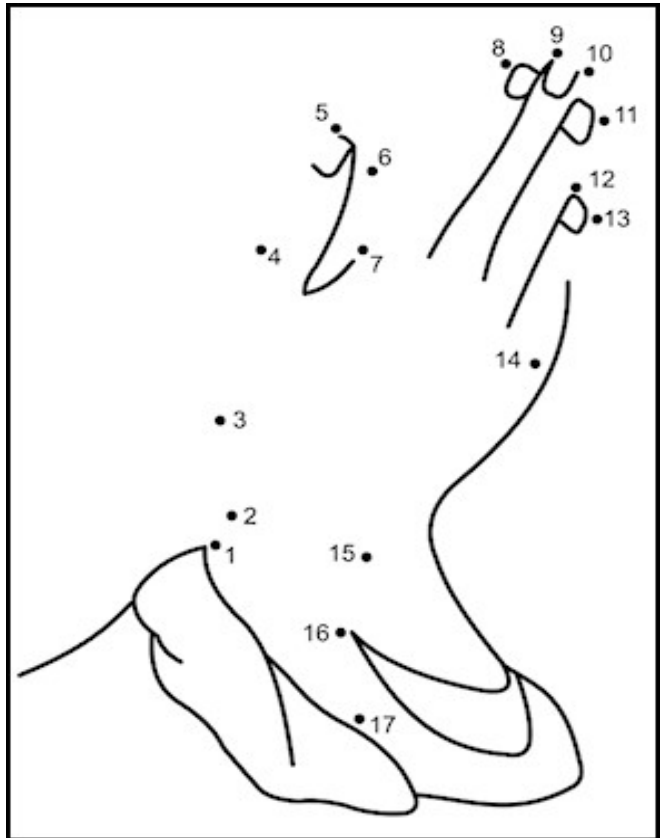
**Rev. Dr. Olaf Roynesdal will be retiring from full time ministry

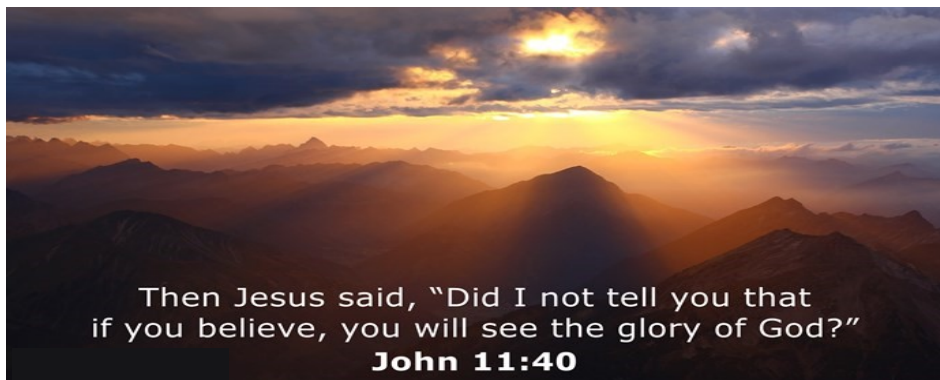
